

Directions from Brown University

To I-95

From the Admission Office, turn onto Angell Street and starting with the traffic light on the corner of Angell and Prospect Sts. count 5 sets of lights, you will be at Memorial Blvd. Turn right onto Memorial Blvd. to the 2nd set of lights. Once you cross that intersection you will see the ramps for I-95 North and South.

To I-93/Route 128

From the Admission Office proceed to I-95. Take I-95 North 30 miles to the junction of I-95/Route 128/I-93, the expressway around Boston. Bear left and I-95 North/Route 128W takes you west/north toward New Hampshire, Maine, Vermont; bear right and I-93/Route 128E takes you to east/north of Boston.

To Amherst College (Amherst, MA) *(driving time - 2 hours)*

Take I-95 North to Route 146 North. Follow Route 146 North to Route 20 West (left exit). Take Route 20 West to I-90 (Mass Turnpike). Take I-90 to Exit 4 (I-91). Take I-91 North to Exit 19 (Route 9). Take Route 9 East to Route 116 South. These roads intersect at a stoplight at the top of a hill. Most Amherst College buildings are in front of you and on your right; downtown Amherst is on your left.

To Boston University (Boston, MA) *(driving time - 1 hour)*

Follow directions to I-93. Take Route 93/Route 3 North to Exit 26 (Storrow Drive/Back Bay). Go west on Storrow Drive; follow directions above to the Kenmore Square exit and the University.

To Connecticut College (New London, CT) *(driving time - 1 hour)*

Take I-95 South. Just over the Groton Gold Star Bridge, take Exit 84 North from southbound I-95 to Route 32 North. College entrance is one mile on left.

To Dartmouth College (Hanover, NH) *(driving time - 3 to 3.5 hours)*

Follow directions to I-93. Take I-93 North to I-89 North at Concord, N.H. Get off I-89 at Exit 18 in Lebanon, N.H. onto Route 120. (A sign says that it is the exit for Dartmouth College.) Bear right off the exit, heading North on Route 120 into Hanover. 4.1 miles from the Exit, Route 120 forks at a traffic light. Bear right at the fork, following Route 120 one-half mile on South Park Street to the second traffic light. Turn left at the light, onto East Wheelock Street. Follow East Wheelock for two-tenths of a mile, when you will come to the Hopkins Center (left) and the Dartmouth Green (right).

To Hampshire College (Amherst, MA) *(driving time - 2 hours)*

Take I-95 North to Route 146 North/West to I-90 West. Take I-90 (Mass Turnpike) to Exit 4 (I-91). Take I-91 North to Exit 19 (Route 9). Take Route 9 East into Amherst. At the town center turn right onto Route 116 and drive south 3 miles to Hampshire College.

To Harvard University (Cambridge, MA) *(driving time - 1 hour)*

Follow directions to I-93. Bear left towards Dedham on I-95/Route 128 North to I-90 (Mass Turnpike). Follow the Turnpike East. Take Exit 18 (Cambridge/Allston). Bear right after the toll booth at the end of the exit ramp. At the third set of lights (over the bridge), turn left onto Memorial Drive. After the second set of lights, turn right onto JFK Street. Go through two sets of lights. At the third set of lights, turn left onto Brattle Street (Cardullo's is straight ahead), then bear right at the crosswalk (Eastern Mountain Sports is straight ahead), which is a continuation of Brattle Street. Radcliffe Yard will be on your right after you pass the Graduate School of Education on your right and the American Repertory Theatre on your left. The Admissions Office is located within Radcliffe Yard.

To Mount Holyoke (South Hadley, MA) *(driving time - 2 hours)*

Take I-95 North to Route 146 North. Follow Route 146 North to Route 20 West (left exit). Take Route 20 West to Route I-90 West (Mass Turnpike). Take Exit 5 (Holyoke/Chicopee) and bear to the right. At the end of the ramp, turn left on Route 33 for five miles to Route 116. Turn right onto 116 and drive approximately 1.5 miles north to the College.

To Providence College (Providence, RI) *(driving time - 15 minutes)*

Take I-95 North, to Exit 23 (State Offices). Turn right onto Orms Street. After the first light, veer right onto Douglas Avenue (Route 7). Proceed 0.7 miles to the third light on Douglas and make a left-hand turn onto Eaton Street. Proceed about 0.6 miles to the second light at the intersection of Eaton Street and River Avenue. The gate of the campus will be on your right.

To Smith College (Northampton, MA) *(driving time - 2 hours)*

Take I-95 North to Route 146 North. Follow 146 North to Route 20 West (left exit). Take Route 20 West to I-90 (Mass Turnpike); follow the Turnpike West. Take Exit 4 and follow signs for I-91 North. Northampton is on Route I-91 in Massachusetts. Take Exit 18, and follow Route 5 North into the center of town. Turn left onto Route 9. Go straight through four traffic lights, turning left into Smith's main entrance (College Lane) shortly after the fourth set. The Office of Admission is on your right, overlooking Paradise Pond. Parking is available next to the office or along Route 9.

To Tufts University (Medford, MA) *(driving time - 1 hour)*

Follow directions to I-93. Bear left on I-95/Route 128N towards Dedham. Take Route 95 North to Route 2 East (Exit 29A). At the junction of Routes 2 and 16, bear left through a full traffic light on Route 16 East. Take Route 16 East through two full traffic lights. You will see blue signs on the right for Tufts University. Follow the blue signs and take a sharp right up the hill on Powder House Boulevard. At the third traffic light turn left onto Packard Avenue.

To Wesleyan University (Middletown, CT) *(driving time - 2 hours)*

Take I-95 South to Connecticut Route 9 North. Take Exit 15 onto Washington Street (Route 66 West). Turn left onto High Street.

To Williams College (Williamstown, MA) *(driving time - 3 hours)*

Take I-95 North to Route 146 North. Follow Route 146 to Route 20 West (left exit). Take Route 20 West to I-90 (Mass Turnpike). Follow Turnpike West to Lee (Exit 2). Take Route 20 West to Route 7 North. Follow Route 7 North to Route 2 East.

To University of Massachusetts at Amherst (Amherst, MA) *(driving time - 2 hours)*

Take I-95 North to Route 146 North. Follow Route 146 North to Route 20 West (left exit). Take Route 20 West to I-90 (Mass Turnpike). From I-90 (Mass Pike), take Exit 4 (West Springfield). Follow I-91 North to Exit 19. From the exit ramp, turn right onto Route 9. Travel approximately 4.5 miles to Route 116 North (turn left at traffic lights). UMass exit is 1 mile.

To The University of Rhode Island (Kingston, RI) *(driving time - 1 hour)*

Take I-95 South to Exit 9 (Route 4 South); follow Route 4 to Route 1 South. Stay on Route 1 until the intersection of Route 138 West. Route 138 West will bring you to the University.

To Yale University (New Haven, CT) *(driving time – 2 hours)*

Take I-95 South to Connecticut I-91 North in New Haven (left exit); take Exit 3 (Trumbull Street) Stay in the middle lane and continue straight onto Trumbull Street through three traffic lights. At the fourth traffic light, turn right on to Hillhouse Avenue.
