

Information for Completing the Student Visa for Summer Study in Italy

Thank you in advance for collecting the information we require for your visa application. The Consulate has asked us to request the visas at one time.

The Consulate's web site is http://www.consbooston.esteri.it/Consolato_Boston

You must submit a complete application packet **PLUS ONE COPY** of the entire packet:

The completed application packet includes:

your passport* (which must be signed and valid for at least 3 months following the end of your stay in Italy),

one copy of the inside photo page of your passport,

one official passport-size photograph,

and a copy of your paid travel itinerary showing the exact dates of your entry and exit from Italy.

*Students who are not US Citizens must provide a copy of your green card or I-20 and F-1 visa.

In order to participate in a Brown program in Italy, you must have Italian international health insurance. Brown will make the arrangements for this purchase.

Dates

You are responsible for your own travel arrangements – enter the information specific to your travel plans, keeping in mind the following program-specific information:

BOLOGNA

Program housing is available from June 11, 2007 (Bologna). The Program concludes on July 21 at 12PM. Students may not stay in their apartments once the program is finished. For Bologna, we recommend that you fly in to Bologna.

ROME

Program housing is available beginning June 25, 2007 (Rome). For Rome, we recommend that you fly in to Rome. The program will finish in Sorrento on August 8. Students may make their own travel arrangements from Sorrento after the program is completed. A bus will take students to the airport in Rome on August 8. Those students wishing to depart Rome on August 8 should plan to do so after 2PM.
