Terms and Conditions of the Brown Card Declining Balance Account

The Account Holder agrees to the following terms and conditions:

1. No cash withdrawals can be made from this account.
2. The declining Balance Account can be used at the Bookstore, Computer store, University Food Service Operations, and to transfer funds for vending, laundry, copier machines, and video rentals etc. It may not be used to pay the student bill.
3. The maximum value transferable to the vending stripe is \$20.00 per day.
4. If the Account Holder's card is lost, stolen, or damaged, the cash value on the card stripe is lost.
5. A lost, stolen, or damaged card must be immediately reported to the Brown Card Office or Campus Police and Security.
6. Any balance remaining at the end of a semester will automatically be rolled over to the next semester.
7. Money deposited to this account will be refunded only upon graduation or withdrawal from the University. [Exception: if the University is forced to draw from the account to clear the student account (student bill), only the unused balance will be refunded.]
