East Asian Studies and Ancient Studies were moved from Social Sciences to Humanities, Community Health from Social Sciences to Life Sciences, and Latin American Studies from Humanities to the Social Sciences. Previous years' data for these concentrations were moved retroactively.

In 2005 the Gender Studies program merged with the concentration in Sexuality and Society to form the Gender and Sexuality Studies Program.

In 2005 Literary Arts became a program separate from Literatures in English.

In 2008-09 Latin American Studies was renamed Latin American & Caribbean Studies.
