Most OIR tables count distinct students for the academic year. The exception to this rule is the counting of special students in Tables 8a and 8b, which count student/semesters. Although the default assumption is that a special student is typically here for a semester, a significant number of special students enroll in consecutive semesters. Counting student/semesters takes this variation into account.
