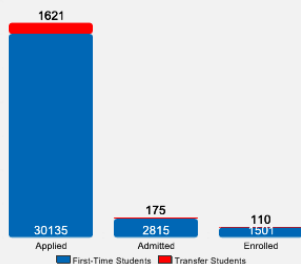
Brown University adheres to a collaborative university-college model in which faculty are as committed to teaching as they are to research, embracing a curriculum that requires students to be architects of their education.

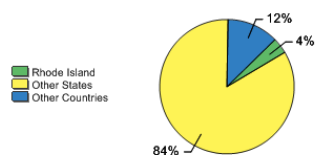

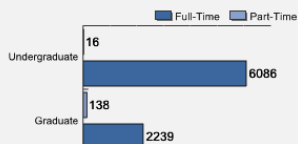

### Fall 2010 Freshman Class Geographical Profile



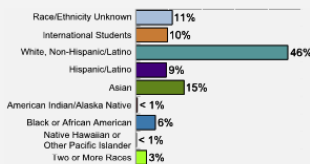
### Fall 2010 Enrollment

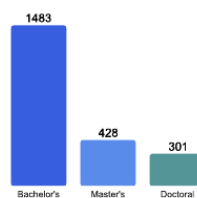

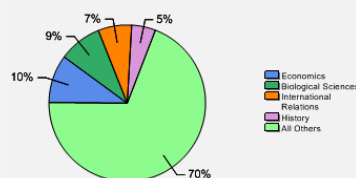

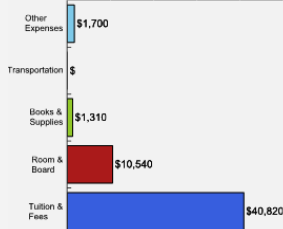

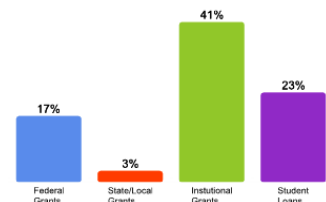

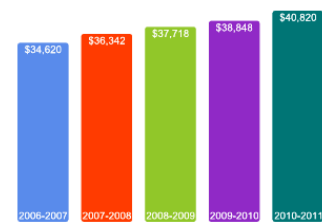
