- Basic language courses are not all given a line item, course numbers are listed in a range. Courses dealing with language through literature, themes, etc., are given their own line items because they expand culturally specific content.

Column C: Course title as listed in BOCA online catalogue OR name/description of project

Column D: Faculty person responsible

Column E: Special topics: this is an effort to help sort out emergent themes that might point to non-geographically based commonalities among Brown course offerings. Tentative and based solely on the reader's impression from course description, they are offered as a possible tool to be used or ignored.
