## 2007 BICYCLE REGISTRATION WEEK

The Brown University Department of Public Safety Crime Prevention Unit will be sponsoring its annual Bicycle Registration Week in September. The registration times are from 10:00am to 3:00pm. Your student ID number will be engraved on the frame and wheel rims of the bicycle and a decal applied to the bicycle frame.

Registering your bicycle with the Crime Prevention Unit enables DPS to return a lost or stolen bicycle to its owner should it be recovered. Also, if your bicycle should need to be removed from a location, or if the lock needs to be cut off because you lost your key or forgot your lock combination, this facilitates that process. Most of all, having a decal applied to your bicycle frame acts as a visible deterrent to the would-be thief.

You can also register your bicycle on-line from the DPS web site. Once Crime Prevention receives your on-line registration, you will be assigned a registration number. A registration certificate along with a decal will be sent to you. Registering your bicycle on-line is quick and easy. Once you receive the decal, it is to be placed on the upper support bar just below the gooseneck of the handlebars.
