The Department of Public Safety (DPS) is making available the Annual Security Report to all members of the Brown Community. This report contains information on campus security, policies and procedures at Brown University, as well as certain crime statistics reported to DPS and Providence Police.

The safety and well being of our students, faculty, staff, alumni and visitors is top priority. DPS is committed to providing the highest level of professional police and public safety services and works in conjunction with several departments and agencies to ensure and maintain a safe learning and working environment.

The information provided in this report is designed to be resource and to alert the campus community of the current programs, policies and procedures related to crime awareness and reporting at Brown University. This report also includes statistics for the previous three years concerning reported crimes that occurred: on campus, in certain off-campus buildings, property owned or controlled by Brown University, and on public property within or immediately adjacent to and accessible from the campus.

This information is being provided in accordance to the Jeanne Clery Disclosure of Campus Security Policy and Campus Crime Statistics Act (20 USC § 1092(f)). The Jeanne Clery Act is federal law that requires colleges and universities across the United States to disclose timely and annual information about campus crime and security polices. We encourage all members of the Brown University Community to use this report as a guide and to take an active role in maximizing your personal safety, both on and off campus.

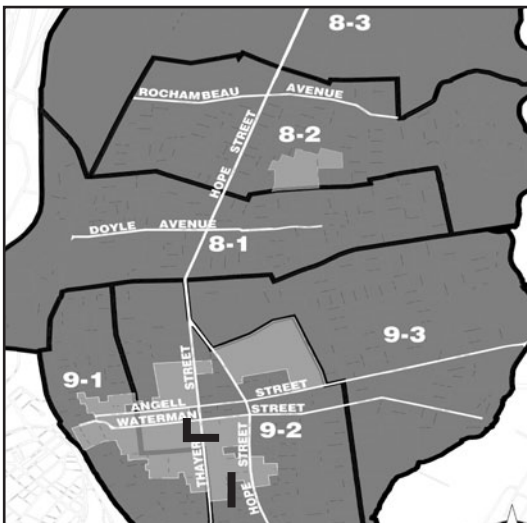
