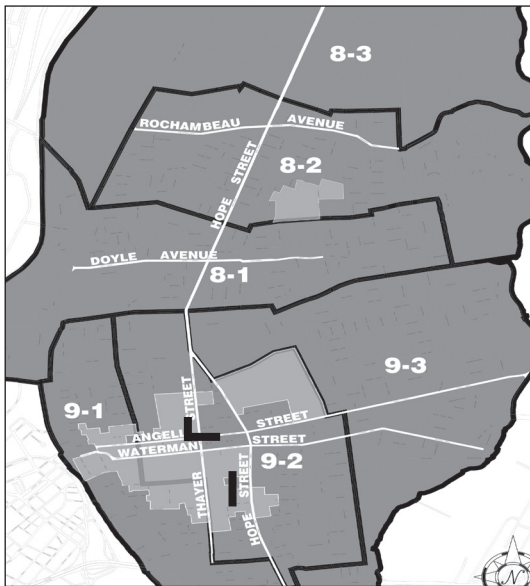


# PROVIDENCE POLICE DEPARTMENT — CRIMINAL OFFENSE STATISTICS

Non-campus buildings or facilities: In 2005 and 2006 there were no reportable statistics for non-campus buildings or facilities as defined by the CCR. **Reportable Hate Crimes** (murder/non-negligent manslaughter, aggravated assault, forcible sex offenses, rape, arson, negligent manslaughter, simple assault)

2004 – one (sexual orientation/simple assault/on campus)

2005 – one (sexual orientation/simple assault/public property)

2006 – one (ethnicity/robbery/public property)

### Non-Reportable Hate Crimes (Intimidation, vandalism)

2004 – fourteen (seven race, five sexual orientation, two religious)

2005 – eleven (two race, seven sexual orientation, two ethnicity)

2006 – twelve (one religious, five sexual orientation, six race)
