Move-In Safety Tips For Students



Protect Your Property!



Move in day is fast approaching, and the excitement is growing! Upon arriving to campus, please take into consideration the following tips to protect your personal property:

- ⇒ Be sure to secure your vehicle between trips to your room.
- ⇒ Never leave boxes unattended outside your vehicle, near the residence hall entrance, or in a hallway. Have a relative or friend keep an eye out for your belongings while your away. Theft happens!
- ⇒ Secure your room when left unattended; and encourage your roommate to do the same during the move-in process. Showing mutual concern for safety is a great ice breaker! Or simply ask a parent to stay in the room while making trips to get more stuff!
- ⇒ As residence hall doors are often propped open during move-in, keep in eye out for persons behaving suspiciously and *leaving* the building with property. Report suspicious circumstances to Public Safety at 863.3322.
- ⇒ Consider leaving your most treasured items at home! Secure those must have valuables such as jewelry, heirlooms, credit cards, etc. in a safe place in your room out of plain view for increased security.
- ⇒ Secure bicycles to a bike rack. Use a horseshoe style lock, as opposed to a cable or chain.
