Date & Time Reported	Incident Type	Location	Summary/Disposition
12/06/10 10:42am	Attempted Breaking & Entering	Alumnae Hall	An employee reported that when she arrived for work a window in her office was open about six inches. Upon further inspection she noticed the screen was up a few inches and also pushed off its track. Nothing from the office was missing. A Brown University detective responded to the scene for processing. Facilities was notified to fix the window.
12/06/10 10:57am	Larceny	Brown Bookstore	Manager of the Bookstore reported that on Thursday 12/02/10 at approximately 3:10pm an unidentified black male entered the Bookstore and shopped around the store for about ten minutes. He then asked a store employee to let him into a changing room to try on items he had pick off the clothes rack. After about ten minutes he exited the changing room without the items and walked toward the exit. The employee asked the suspect if he was all set, when he replied "What, you think I'm stealing something?" She did not question the suspect any further and he exited the building. The items reported stolen are described as a gray Brown University t-shirt and a pair of Brown University sweat pants.
12/08/10 9:51am	Larceny	Brown Stadium	Football coach reported that two football jerseys were stolen from the football locker room under the home stands. He reported that the assistant equipment manager set up a display of eight football jerseys and equipment in the lockers for football recruits on 12/03/10 at 9:15am. He stated that when he responded to the stadium locker room to check out the display he noticed that the rug in the locker room needed to be vacuumed. He notified Facilities Management to have the locker room cleaned. On 12/04/10 at noon when he returned to the football locker room he noticed that two football jerseys were missing from the display. Numbers 11 and 20 were missing from the locker. He reported that the stadium and football locker room were found locked and secured and that the locker room had been cleaned.

12/13/10 5:31pm	Larceny	Stephen Robert '62 Campus Center	Student reported items of hers were taken on 12/02/2010 between 6:30pm and 6:50pm. She stated she left her book bag and items on a table near the information desk. When she returned her bag was still there, but other items were missing.
12/18/10 11:25am	Breaking & Entering/ No Force	Sears House	Student reported that between 11/22/10 at 3pm and 11am on 12/18/10 person (s) unknown entered her room, using no force and took a scarf and handbag. No suspects at this time.
12/20/10 1:55pm	Larceny	Dyer House	Employee reported her cell phone was stolen from her desk between 11am and noon. The door to her office and building were unlocked.
