06/08/09 12:26pm	Simple Assault	George Street	Officer responded to take a report from a Brown University employee. Upon arrival, the complainant stated that at approximately 12:15pm he was walking on the sidewalk on George Street. When he reached the area of Horace Mann, he observed a white colored sedan and observed a male hanging out the front passenger's window. That male then threw an egg at him, hitting him in the upper chest. He stated he could not identify the suspects but just wanted to inform DPS. He also declined medical attention.
06/09/09 3:29pm	Narcotic Violation	Chapin House	An officer was dispatched to meet with Residential Life's Assistant Director for Operations who stated that he received an e-mail from employees of Environmental Health and Safety stating that during an administrative room search they found a green pipe. The officer seized the item and brought them to department headquarters.
06/09/09 3:29pm	Weapons Violation	Harkness House	An officer was dispatched to meet with Residential Life's Assistant Director for Operations who stated that he received an e-mail from employees of Environmental Health and Safety stating that during an administrative room search they found various sizes of swords and a crossbow with a scope and a six inch knife. The officer seized the items and brought them to department headquarters.
06/09/09 3:29pm	Narcotic Violation	Goddard House	An officer was dispatched to meet with Residential Life's Assistant Director for Operations who stated that he received an e-mail from employees of Environmental Health and Safety stating that during an administrative room search they found a blue pipe with wooden ends, a clear glass pipe sitting on top of a silver pot with water in it located on the floor near a couch and 3 small glass style pipes. The officer seized the items and brought them to department headquarters.

06/10/09 1:06pm	Larceny	Life Sciences	Employee reported that she left her office at approximately 10:30 am. When she returned back to her office at noon, she found the sliding glass window open and the office door open. Stolen from the top of her desk was her pink wallet. She reported that the sliding glass window was closed and the door was locked. It appeared that someone pushed open the sliding glass window to unlock the office door. The office window was unlocked. She stated that she found her wallet approximately one hour later in the wastebasket in the kitchen area. Stolen from her wallet was twenty dollars.
06/22/09 12:35am	Suspicious Circumstance	Bronson House	At approximately 1am an officer was dispatched to meet a party in the lounge. Upon arrival he was met by a Residential Assistant who stated that approximately midnight he saw a white male inside the area of the lounge. When he approached this man he asked him what he was doing inside the building. The male stated to him that his name was Ted Dawson and he was working with Ted's Construction. He asked him where his ID and his supervisor were. The male in question then stated to him he was waiting for his supervisor to meet him there to lay some wires throughout the building and that he had talked to his supervisor and was told that he was running late. He then escorted the male out of the building. It should be noted that he notified DPS approximately 40 minutes after the incident.

Upon his return on 06/22/2009 at 1:30 pm he noticed the room door opened and his wallet missing from the top of his desk and his suitcase opened and disheveled. Also, his shampoo bottle that was on the desk was knocked off and shampoo was all over the floor. I asked about his roommate and he did not know where he was at this time.

06/29/09 9:26pm	Assist Providence Police / Breaking & Entering	242 Meeting Street	A Brown student stated that his roommate arrived home at 3:30pm and she noticed that the front door was unlocked to the apartment. At 6pm he arrived home and noticed his room had been broken into. Missing were a laptop, camera, video game system and video games. Providence Police were on scene and took a report.
07/04/09 7:38pm	Suspicious Circumstance	Thayer Street John Street	Brown summer students stated that while walking on Thayer Street, an unknown white male walked by and pretended to be on his cell phone. He then took a photo of the girls and quickly walked away. A search of the area but with negative results. The same officer then responded with Providence Police to John Street in reference to a similar complaint that had been broadcasted by PPD.
