Date & Time Reported	Incident Type	Location	Summary/Disposition
08/15/09 9:07am	Larceny	Pizzitola Sports Center	Student reported the wheels were stolen from her bicycle that was locked to the bike rack sometime between 08/08/09 at 3pm and 08/15/09 at 3pm. She said the bicycle was secured to the rack with a Kryptonite lock, but the lock was attached to the frame and not the wheels.
08/18/09 9:32am	Suspicious Behavior / Person	CIT Building	An employee reported that she went to the women's restroom on the first floor and as she exited a restroom stall, a white male subject exited a stall at the same time. He was described as having short brown hair, approximately 5'08" tall, average build, wearing a white t-shirt with a design on the front, casual khaki pants and a tan colored backpack. The employee said "excuse me you are in the ladies room", and the male subject put his head down and walked out. She said the male never spoke to her and she watched him walk out of the front doors and then called DPS. The area was checked but no one matching the description was found.
08/22/09 7:06am	Breaking & Entering / No Force	Chapin House	Student reported that he left all his belongings in the hallway outside of his room on 08/22/2009 at 1am. When he got up on 08/22/2009 at 7am and checked the hallway he noticed his 42 inch plasma television missing, but everything else was there.

08/22/09 9:07am	Breaking & Entering / Force	Aquatics Bubble	Assistant water polo coach said that he locked the pool on 08/21/2009 at 8:20pm and on 08/22/2009 at 9:10am he found the front door slide lock bent and the door was open. He said that someone came in and used the pool because there was eight to ten water polo balls floating in the pool and when he locked up the night before the balls were not in the pool.
08/24/09 6:17pm	Assist Providence Police / Larceny	Cooke and Benevolent Streets	While on patrol, a Brown University police officer observed a male party bent down in the front seat of a vehicle and it appeared that he was attempting to brush glass off the car seat area. She stopped and asked him if he was all set and he stated that his vehicle had been broken into. Brown University visiting scholar stated that he arrived at approximately 8:30am and parked his vehicle, locked the doors and set the alarm. He stated that he left his new GPS on the front windshield area with the accessories plug. He stated that he had just purchased the GPS yesterday for \$200.00. The passenger side window was smashed and there was no other damage sustained to the vehicle. There was nothing else taken in the break. Providence Police were called to the scene to take a report.
08/26/09 11:20am	Larceny	Hunter Lab	It was reported that a portrait of professor Walter Hunter was stolen. An employee reported that the last time the portrait was seen on the wall in the auditorium was sometime between July 27th and August 5th 2009. General access to the auditorium can be gained and the area is normally left open. No sign of force or damage found.
08/28/09 3:54pm	Assist Providence Police / Larceny	Lloyd Ave and Hope Street	While on patrol a Brown University police officer observed Providence Police on scene and was advised that a vehicle had just been broken into. The Providence officer stated that a witness had seen three males breaking into the vehicle owned by a Brown employee. The passenger side window was smashed and two headlights were removed from the vehicle.

08/29/09 4:36pm	Assist Providence Police / Miscellaneous Hazardous Condition	Site of the Center for Creative Arts	An officer was dispatched for a report a water leak in the retaining wall near the new Center for Creative Arts. Upon arrival the officer spoke with the site manager who stated that due to the heavy rain the south retaining wall located on the Angell street side of the construction site began to collapse. This incident also caused the water main that is connected to the fire hydrant on Angell street to break. This caused massive amounts of water to pour into the construction site area. Also, at the same time there was another water main break on the Olive Street side of the construction area. This also contributed to large amounts of water emptying into the site. The Providence Water Department was on scene and two Providence Police details were called in and assigned to traffic control. Providence Police also took a report.
08/31/09 11:45am	Larceny	CIT Building	Employee stated that she placed her pocketbook in her desk at 11am. She then stated that she is out of her office often and she closes but does not lock her door. She noticed her pocketbook missing at 11:45am. The Brown University police officer who responded began to check trash receptacles in the area and in the men's room; he located in the trash bin, under paper towels, the pocketbook that was stolen from the office. He brought the pocketbook back to the complainant and she determined that all items were still in the pocketbook except seventy dollars cash.
09/01/09 8:54am	Larceny	Lot 90	Employee stated that on 08/31/09 at approximately 11am he parked his vehicle. When he returned to his vehicle at 11:45am he noticed that his wallet with cash, credit cards and driver's license and his iPod were missing. According to the complainant there were no signs of forced entry into the vehicle.
