Date & Time Reported	Incident Type	Location	Summary/Disposition
09/17/09 3:09pm	Larceny	Marcy House	Student reported his bicycle was taken from the bike rack and he stated that he was "pretty sure" he locked up the bicycle with a cable lock on 09/16/2009 at 7pm. When he returned on 09/17/2009 at noon he noticed the bicycle missing.
09/18/09 2:26pm	Larceny	Life Sciences	Complainant reported that half of her ice cream birthday cake was stolen from a refrigerator in a common area. The incident occurred sometime between 3pm on 09/17/09 and 2pm on 09/18/09. She also reported that other food items were also stolen from the refrigerator in that area in the past couple of days and months prior, that belong to other students that work in the labs on that floor. The common area room does not have a lock on that door and access can be gained by anyone.
09/21/09 11:29am	Larceny	Sharpe Refectory	Student stated that on 09/19/09 at approximately 5pm he left his backpack. He remembered that he left his backpack at 11:30pm. He contacted DPS. DPS responded and was unable to locate the backpack. On 09/20/09 he went back to the Sharpe Refectory and looked through the lost and found but the backpack was not there. The backpack contained a laptop, I Touch, and one book.
09/21/09 12:23pm	Larceny	New Pembroke #4	Student stated her wallet was stolen on 09/16/09. She stated that she was at a friend's room with fifteen other Brown students when her wallet went missing. She searched the room but could not locate the wallet.

09/21/09 2150	Breaking & Entering / No Force	Bronson House	Student stated that at approximately 9:40pm she left her room and went to the laundry room. Her room door was approximately 3 inches ajar and the laundry room is fifty feet up the corridor. When she returned to her room approximately 10 minutes later her laptop was stolen from her desk. The laptop was unplugged and cords were left behind. No witnesses or suspects.
