10/02/09 12:29pm	Larceny	Morriss Hall	Student reported that sometime between 7pm and 7:10pm hours on Monday, 09/28/09, persons unknown took her wallet. The wallet contained her Brown ID and cash. She reported that she had been studying and that some of her friends had come into the lounge. She took her phone and went to the other side of the lounge for about 10 minutes. She reported that she could see her study area, and did periodically look over. When she returned, her wallet and its contents were gone. She reported that she had not seen anyone near her belongings.
