Date & Time Reported	Incident Type	Location	Summary/Disposition
10/08/09 12:29pm	Larceny	Barus & Holley	Media Services employees reported that a pair of speakers were stolen from a classroom sometime between 10pm on 10/06/09 and 10pm on 10/07/09. The speakers were bolted to a bracket on the wall in the room.
10/09/09 10:05am	Larceny	Alumnae Hall	An employee reported that a data projector was stolen from a classroom. Video and alarm wires were found hanging from the ceiling where the projector was mounted. The reporting person stated that the missing projector was last checked by Media Services on the week of September 4, 2009. Nothing else was reported stolen or damaged and there were no signs of forced entry.
10/09/09 9:08pm	Breaking & Entering / No Force	Andrews Hall	Student stated he left his room at 8:30pm and when he returned at 9:07pm his laptop had been stolen. He originally told the officers the door was locked when he returned, then later said it was ajar when he returned. Officers inspected the door and found no visible signs of forced entry, yet the student said he was positive he left with his door locked.
10/09/09 11:40pm	Breaking & Entering / No Force	Andrews Hall	Student stated that approximately 11:35pm she was in her room alone and left for about five minutes to go to the restroom. Upon leaving, she left the door unlocked and slightly open. She stated that when she returned she noticed that her laptop and her roommate's laptop were missing from their desks. She stated that she checked her room and found nothing else missing.

10/11/09 1:46am	Breaking & Entering / No Force	Everett House	Student stated that at approximately 1:30am he left his dorm room and went to the restroom nearest to the room. His roommate then left the room to visit a friend and left the room open. When he returned from the restroom he noticed that their laptops were missing along with a set of headphones.
10/11/09 2:27am	Breaking & Entering / No Force	Wayland House	Brown student reported that sometime between 12:30am and 2:30am an unknown person entered her unlocked room and removed her laptop from her bed. Her roommate was sleeping in the room during this time period but she did not see or hear anything.
10/11/09 10:59pm	Breaking & Entering / No Force	Caswell Hall	Student stated that at approximately 10:30pm she was headed downstairs to cook when an unknown subject entered the building. She let the subject in as he stated that he had lost his swipe card. She asked the unknown subject where he lived and he stated "3" and she continued heading downstairs and the unknown subject ran upstairs. Approximately thirty minutes later she and her roommate returned back to their room and noticed that a laptop, iPhone, and debit cards were missing. The door to the room was left unlocked and open.
10/12/09 11:06am	Larceny	Sharpe Refectory	Student stated that she locked her bike to the bike rack with a u lock on 10/01/09 at 6:30pm. On 10/08/09 at 9:30am she returned to the bike rack to get her bike and it was not there.

10/12/09 11:30am	Breaking & Entering / No Force	Marcy House	Student said she left her room at about 6pm hours on 10/11/09 and left her room unlocked. When she returned to her room at 2am her laptop was missing. She said that a few students told her that they saw a male with curly blond hair, medium build and medium height wearing plaid shorts walking through the dorm opening up dorm room doors around 1:30am.
10/12/09 3:40pm	Breaking & Entering / No Force	VG Quad A	Student stated his laptop was taken from a couch in the suite common area. The door to the suite was left propped open.
10/12/09 7:07pm	Larceny	Sharpe Refectory	Student reported that after using his ID to pay for his meal, he placed his case containing his ID card and his debit card on the table with his food. He then went to obtain silverware and returned to finish eating. He noticed his debit card missing from the case when he returned to his room.
10/13/09 11:05am	Larceny	180 George Street	An electrical worker stated that he left his iPod on top of his sweatshirt on 10/09/09 at 8am. He noticed the it missing when he was getting ready to leave for the day at 3pm.
10/13/09 1519	Assist Providence Police / Robbery	Main Green	The victim and a friend, both Hope High School students, stated that two unknown males approached the victim and assaulted him with a metal stake causing him to receive a laceration on the top of his right eye. It was later learned that one of the suspects also reached into the victim's pants and took his RIPTA bus pass. Brown University and Providence Police searched the area but did not locate the suspects.

She did not report it right away because she was not sure if the clothes were stolen or misplaced, but with the recent reports of other students having their clothes stolen, she decided to report it when she saw the officers.
