10/15/09 8:27am	Breaking & Entering / No Force	Hegeman Hall E	Student reported that she left her room on 10/14/09 at 5pm and locked her room door. When she returned to her room on 10/15/09 at 1:10am her room door was unlocked and her roommates were asleep in their rooms. When she entered her room she noticed that her laptop computer was missing from her desk. One of her roommates stated that when she returned to her room at 7:30pm on 10/14/09 her room door was locked but that she left the room door open after that time and that she and another roommate went to bed at 10pm. They reported they heard the room door open at 12:15am and thought it was their roommate coming in and went back to sleep.
10/18/09 1:42am	Assist Providence Police / Miscellaneous Noise Complaint	Wickenden Street	Brown University Police were dispatched in reference to a loud party involving Brown University students. Upon arrival they met with Providence officers who had already dispersed the party. Two Brown University students were issued citations by the Providence Police.
10/18/09 1:19pm	Assist Providence Police / Larceny	Charlesfield and Brown Streets	Complainant stated that between 10am and 1pm on 10/18/09 person (s) unknown broke the passenger's window on his rental car and took his GPS from the dashboard.
10/18/09 2:55pm	Breaking & Entering / No Force	Goddard House	Upon arrival a Brown police officer was met by two student victims. One stated that she left her room at midnight and returned home at 2am and went to bed. Her door was left unlocked from midnight until the time the theft was discovered. Her roommate was not in the room during the night. She returned to her room in the morning. Items stolen were: laptop, a pocketbook containing a credit card, debit card and a key to the room. Facilities Management was notified and responded to change the locks.

When they heard that their friends downstairs had items stolen they searched their room and noticed that their TV accessory that stores music and rents movies over the internet was missing.
