Date & Time Reported	Incident Type	Location	Summary/Disposition
10/23/09 10:27am	Larceny	86 Waterman Street	Student stated that he last saw his bicycle locked to a pole on 10/22/2009 at 11:30pm. On 10/23/2009 at 10:27am he noticed his bicycle and lock missing. The pole that his bicycle was locked to was approximately 5 feet tall and is used as a tree support pole so it was possible that someone just picked up the bicycle and lock over the pole.
10/26/09 11:56pm	Larceny	Morriss Hall	Student stated his wallet was stolen from the game room between 11:15pm and 11:45pm. He stated that there were four unknown males in the room during that time and that they left the room before he noticed his wallet missing.
10/27/09 5:32pm	Assist Providence Police / Larceny	Olive & Prospect Streets	A Brown employee reported that sometime between 3:45pm hours and 5pm, person(s) unknown smashed the passenger side front door window on his vehicle and took a GPS system that had been mounted on the front windshield.

10/31/09 1:55am	Breaking & Entering / Force	Bronson House	Student reported that sometime between 9:15pm on 10/30/2009 and 1:50am on 10/31/2009 an unknown person entered his room and removed several items of value. His room door was locked during this period of time but the window was pushed open and the screen was cut. Items stolen were a flat screen tv, gaming console and game, a digital camera and a vacuum. There is a suspect at this time and the case is under investigation.
10/31/09 11:25am	Breaking & Entering / No Force	Sears House	Student stated that at around 8:30am on 10/31/09 an unknown suspect entered his unsecured room while he was sleeping. He thought that the suspect made a mistake and entered the wrong room. He didn't think anything of it and went back to sleep. The student later discovered that he was missing \$80.00 from his wallet which was on the desk.
10/31/09 10:20am	Breaking & Entering / No Force	Machado House	Student stated that she left her dorm room at about 9:30am and said her roommate was sleeping and that she did not lock the dorm room door. When her roommate woke up at about 11am she noticed the reporting party's laptop was gone. The roommate said while she was sleeping she heard someone enter the room and heard some shuffling at a desk. She thought it was her roommate returning to get something. Inside the computer there were two 20 dollar bills. Also missing was a black leather computer carry case. There is a suspect and the case is under investigation.
10/31/09 1:20pm	Breaking & Entering / No Force	VG Quad A	Student reported that sometime between 11:30pm on 10/30/09 and midnight on 10/31/09, person(s) unknown entered her suite and took her laptop. She reported that it had been on the table in the lounge. The lounge area is just inside the main entry door and she reported that the door to the suite had been left ajar during the evening.

10/31/09 5:05pm	Breaking & Entering / No Force	Grad Tower C	Student victim stated that he left his suite at 12:30am. He left his door propped open and went to a party. He returned to his suite at 2:20am and closed the door. In the morning he noticed that his laptop missing.
10/31/09 2:51am	Breaking & Entering / No Force	Grad Tower C	Brown student stated that he and his roommate left their dorm room around 11:30pm. When they returned about 1:30am they noticed that a TV, two laptops and an iPod were missing from the room. They stated that their dorm room door sometimes does not close on its own. There were no signs of forced entry.
11/01/09 2:46am	Breaking & Entering / No Force	Olney House	Sometime between 12:45am and 1:15am an unknown person entered a student's unlocked dorm room and removed his laptop and speakers. The student was in the bathroom during this period of time.

11/01/09 6:17pm	Assist Providence Police / Larceny	70 Ship Street	Officers were dispatched for a larceny from a motor vehicle. Reporting party stated she noticed a green pocketbook on the sidewalk with the contents spilled out. She determined that the owner was a grad student. The victim stated that she arrived at Ship Street around 5:30pm and parked her vehicle. She hid her pocketbook under a vest and put her GPS in the center console. She left the GPS holder on the front windshield. The victim stated that ten dollars was missing from her pocketbook along with her new GPS. Providence Police took a report and there are suspects at this time.

11/02/09 5:13pm	Larceny	Sharpe Refectory	Student stated that at 3pm he was eating in the Sharpe Refectory and had his laptop on the seat next to him. He left at 3:30pm and went home and an hour later he remembered that he left his laptop. He returned and spoke to several workers but they could not find the laptop.
