Date & Time Reported	Incident Type	Location	Summary/Disposition
01/29/09 1:38pm	Larceny	Horace Mann	Employee stated that from 12pm until 12:30pm she left her office for lunch. When she returned her University owned laptop was missing. She said that she did not lock her door to the office when she went to lunch. There are no suspects at this time.
01/30/09 10:29pm	Breaking & Entering / No Force	King House	Student reported that between the hours of 4pm and 7:55pm, eight bottles of alcohol were taken from a closet.
01/30/09 10:29pm	Lost Property Found Property	King House	Student reported that the fraternity owned projector had been stolen from a storage room in the basement. 02/01/09 12:10pm	Breaking & Entering / No Force	Barbour Hall	A student reported that sometime between 12/19/08 and 02/01/09 her bike pump that was attached to her bike was taken from the bike room.
02/02/09 4:06pm	Larceny	Rockefeller Library	Complainant stated that at approximately 3pm she left her jacket at a desk area and went to the computer area. When she returned to the desk area at approximately 4pm her jacket was gone.
02/04/09 1:08pm	Larceny	Pizzitola	A laptop was stolen from an unlocked office on the third floor. A possible suspect had asked an employee for some information. The male suspect declined to go with the employee into his office to retrieve the information and waited in the hall. When the employee returned with the information the person was gone. It was only minutes later when another employee noticed the laptop missing from his desk. The case is under investigation by Brown University detectives.
