02/13/09 5:49pm	Property Damage / Malicious Intent	Andrews Hall	While performing a security check an officer noticed that several window screens were damaged in the stairwells of the building. They appeared to have been kicked out. There was heavy damage to all the window sills. Facilities Management was notified.
02/16/09 10:02am	Burglary / No Force	Diman House	A student reported that on 02/16/2009 between 2am and 7am an unknown person entered her unlocked room while she was sleeping and removed her laptop from her desk. She stated that she heard someone open the door while she was sleeping however she did not open her eyes to see who it was.

The hinges were disconnected.

02/17/09 4:21pm	Larceny of Motor Vehicle Parts	Lot 77A	Reporting party stated that her factory rims and tires were stolen. On 02/16/09 at approximately 7pm she parked her vehicle. When she returned on 02/17/2009 at approximately 9:30am she realized that her factory rims and tires were stolen.
