02/27/09 7:17am	Property Damage / Malicious Intent	Sears House	An officer was dispatched to meet with a Facilities Management employee who needed to file a report regarding malicious damage. The officer observed water on the floor of the hallway and flooding in another section of the hallway. A hose had been run from the trash room and was still on in the hallway. They then went into the lounge where they thought some more water was coming from. The room's floor was covered with water and beer cans and the walls were covered in black plastic. They also noticed a smell coming from another lounge. In that room was a grill that contained rat traps and a t- shirt. The matter has been turned over to Student Life.
02/27/09 12:09pm	Larceny	Metcalf Research Lab	A professor reported that he left his office at approximately 9:55am to go and teach a class. When he returned back to his office at 10:55am he noticed that his laptop computer and power cord were missing. He reported that the door to his office, which is accessible from the hallway, was locked. Entry was gained through other connecting offices off the hallway that were open and/or unlocked. No sign of forced entry or any damage found. There are no suspects at this time.
03/01/09 9:43am	Larceny	Faunce House	It was reported that there was damage done to a personal products dispenser located in a second floor restroom. The dispenser was pried open and various items were stolen from inside.
03/01/09 12:38pm	Larceny	Rockefeller Library	Student reported that her laptop and wallet were stolen. She left the items unattended and went to make a phone call. When she returned 5-10 minutes later the laptop was gone and her wallet was missing from her backpack. Brown University detectives are investigating.
