03/12/09 9:46am	Suspicious Behavior / Person	Diman House	Student stated that while taking a shower she noticed a hand pull the shower curtain back. She stated that she noticed a male crawling on his hands and knees with an opened cell phone. She stated that she does not know if the suspect took pictures of her. The case is under investigation by Brown University Detectives.
03/12/09 9:55am	Larceny	Hillel	A project manager from Facilities Management reported that approximately four down spouts were stolen and 3 or 4 gutters were damaged.
03/14/09 1:00am	Dangerous / Disruptive Behavior Property Damage / Malicious Intent Trespass Warning	Bronson House	A Brown student and three of his friends caused damage to multiple exit signs throughout the building. The three visitors were trespassed from the University and the case has been turned over to Student Life.
03/16/09 1:35am	Property Damage / Malicious Intent	Grad Tower C	Officers were dispatched and met with a student who informed them that while she was in bed she heard a loud bang. She then saw that her window had been broken. Officers looked for objects in the room that may have caused the damage but did not find anything. The hole was approximately 3/4" in diameter and there were several spider cracks. Facilities Management was notified and there are no suspects at this time.

03/16/09 11:13am	Property Damage / Malicious Intent	Sharpe Refectory	An employee reported damage to lockers in the locker room. Access was not gained into any of the lockers.
03/17/09 3:18pm	Larceny	Faunce House	Student reported that she had left her laptop in a restroom for two hours. When she returned it was gone. There are no suspects or witnesses.
03/17/09 9:44pm	Larceny	CIT	Student stated that at approximately 9pm he placed his backpack on a table in the lobby and went into lecture hall 143. He returned at 9:45pm and found his laptop adapter missing from the pocket of the backpack.
03/18/09 2:16pm	Larceny	Metcalf Chemistry Lab	An employee reported that she left her office for approximately five minutes. When she returned, the Brown University owned laptop she was using was missing. Witnesses reported a suspicious male in the area who was seen waving to various employees and it was also reported that he entered a room and upon seeing two individuals made a comment and ran away.
