04/03/09 1:43am	Dangerous or Disruptive Behavior	Brook and Meeting Streets	An officer responded to the area of Brook and Meeting Streets and observed saw horses in the street and traffic being diverted due to 15-20 students playing ball in front of 442 Brook Street. As the officer spoke to students it was noticed that some of them appeared to be intoxicated. Providence Police also arrived on scene. Brown and Providence Police explained the city violations and dangers of their actions. The case has been turned over to Student Life.
04/03/09 8:38am	Larceny	Sciences Library	Student reported that she left her book bag unattended on 04/02 and 04/03 in the library at various time intervals. She stated that she did not notice that her wallet was missing from her book bag until 3:30am on 04/03 when she was at home. She reported that her wallet contained sixteen hundred dollars in cash, a driver's license, and a credit card that belonged to her friend.

04/05/09 1:58am	Vandalism Malicious Injury to Property Assist Providence Police / Arrest	Urban Environmental Lab	While on patrol, a Brown University security officer observed a male subject tear down a sign and a section of wooden fence. The officer followed the suspect and informed the Brown University police officer that responded to the scene that the suspect was hiding in some bushes. The suspect was taken into custody and turned over to the Providence Police.
04/05/09 3:53pm	Assist Providence Police / Arrest	Gano Street	A Brown University police officer while on patrol investigated the area of 167 Gano Street, an area known for graffiti activity. He spotted two individuals loitering near the wall of the closed off train tunnel. He flagged down a Providence Police patrolman. They approached two subjects who were found to be in possession of 4 cans of spray paint and two bottles of shoe polish. There was an odor of fresh paint in the air and they had paint on their hands and clothing. Providence Police placed the subjects into custody.
