04/10/09 11:03am	Breaking and Entering / No Force	Emery Hall	Two students reported that they each had a laptop stolen from their room. There were no signs of forced entry and there are no suspects at this time.
04/11/09 1:22am	Simple Assault	Alumnae Hall	While on patrol an officer was notified of an assault that occurred. The victim approached the officer and stated that someone punched him while he was attending a party. The officer observed a deep laceration on the victim's bottom lip. The victim stated that he did not know the person that punched him and that he did not want to press charges and refused to provide any suspect information. Brown EMS was contacted and responded to the scene. The victim was transported to Rhode Island Hospital.
04/11/09 9:09am	Larceny from Motor Vehicle	Lot 10	Brown student reported that the last time she had seen her vehicle was at 2am on 04/11/09. There was no damage to her vehicle at that time. On 04/11/2009 at 9:09am a security officer on patrol found the vehicle broken into. The passenger side window was completely smashed out and missing from inside the vehicle was a stereo and thirty dollars.
04/11/09 6:52pm	Larceny	The Gate	A Brown student worker reported she placed her handbag by the supervisor's desk around 4pm when arrived for work. At 4:30pm she made a phone call and then placed her phone in the bag. At approximately 6:45pm she noticed that her handbag was missing which contained her iPhone, dorm key, credit card and \$80 in cash. The area was searched but the handbag was not located. There are no suspects at this time.

04/13/09 7:34pm	Breaking and Entering / No Force	Poland House	A student stated that her laptop was stolen between 4pm and 7pm. Her room was left unlocked during the time of the theft. There are no suspects at this time.
04/14/09 2:57pm	Larceny	Leung Gallery	A Facilities employee reported that six rectangular wooden tables were stolen. The tables were delivered on 04/13/09 at 3pm and were found missing on 04/14/09 at 7am.
04/15/09 4:38pm	Breaking and Entering / No Force	Emery Hall	A student reported she left her room to take a shower. She was out of the room for approximately ten minutes. When she returned, her laptop, as well as her roommate's laptop, was missing. The room was left unlocked. The case is under investigation.
