04/19/09 7:02pm	Breaking & Entering / No Force	Sears House	Student reported her room keys were taken from the bathroom. She stated that at 6:45pm before showering she placed her keys on the counter. When she was through s she noticed her keys missing. She also stated that she heard numerous people come in and out of the bathroom, but did not see anyone. Detectives spoke with several residents but no one could provide any additional information. There are no suspects or witnesses at this time.
