05/14/09 11:09am	Larceny	Lot 77	Complainant stated that between 8am on 05/13/09 and 10am on 05/14/09 person (s) unknown broke into his vehicle through the front passenger window. The suspect then took his stereo from the dashboard. There was also some damage done to the dashboard. There are no suspects at this time.

During this time someone had taken her laptop off the bed from her second floor bedroom. She also stated that her girlfriend's laptop was stolen from the bedroom. She also mentioned that she believes someone had also taken her iPod from upstairs because she is unable to find it at this time. Another individual stated she was at the party and noticed that someone had taken her Brown University leather card case from her pocketbook which was on the bed in the upstairs bedroom.
