09/11/08 1:18pm	Assist Providence Police / Motor Vehicle Theft	Lot behind 80 Brown Street	A professor stated that he parked his vehicle in the lot behind the building at approximately 8:15am. He noticed the vehicle missing at about 1pm. He spoke with colleagues in the building and at least one person saw the vehicle at about 10am. Providence Police arrived and took the report.
09/13/08 9:44pm	Breaking and Entering/ Force Vandalism /Malicious Injury to Property	89 Benevolent Street	Officers were dispatched for a door that was suspected of being kicked in. An officer and a detective on scene entered the building. The building was cleared and was found to be empty. A panel of the aluminum storm door was knocked out of the frame and the front door sustained damage. No other damage to the building was observed and there are no suspects at this time. Facilities Management was notified to repair the front door.
09/14/08 12:17am	Assist Providence Police / Miscellaneous	Brook St. & George St.	A Brown University police officer was dispatched to meet with a Providence police officer that had a Brown University student stopped for an open container of alcohol on a public street. When the Providence officer asked the student for identification he stated he did not have one on him. The officer then asked for his wallet and discovered a fake license from one state and an active license issued to the student from another state. The matter has been turned over to the Student Life.
