Date & Time Reported	Incident Type	Location	Summary/Disposition
09/18/08 9:56pm	Larceny	Josiah's	An officer was dispatched to Josiah's for the report of a larceny of a laptop computer. The complainant stated that he brought his laptop to work and left it in an unsecured storage room. He last saw it on 09/18/08 at 2am. When he returned to work on 09/18/08 at 9:45pm his laptop was missing. The room is left unsecured during the day and many staff members have access.
09/19/08 5:25pm	Larceny	Sciences Library	A Brown student stated that he left his bicycle secured with a u-lock on the bike rack located at the south side of the Sciences Library. He stated that at approximately 2:30pm he observed the bike as he passed by on his way to class. He stated that when he returned to take the bike out at 5:20pm it was gone from the bike rack along with the u-lock. The bike is registered with Operation ID and there are no suspects at this time
09/20/08 3:01am	Assist Providence Police / Miscellaneous	Power Street	A SafeRide driver reported that a student had been riding in the middle seats of the vehicle and began striking the right rear sliding door repeatedly. His actions caused the door to be bent and unable to be shut. The driver also stated that the student got out of the vehicle and ran away. The student was found. Providence Police were called to the scene to take the report for the damaged vehicle and the case has been turned over to Student Life.
09/20/08 5:11pm	Property Damage	83-85 Benevolent Street	While on patrol officers observed a broken window pane. There were no further signs of damage to the building, nor was there any indication of forced entry or trespass into the building Facilities Management was notified and there are no suspects at this time.

09/20/08 12:00pm	Alcohol Violation	Brown Stadium	Two kegs and a funnel were confiscated from students who were tailgating in the lot during the football game. The matter has been turned over to Student Life.
09/21/08 4:25pm	Property Damage / Malicious Intent	Olive Street and Angell Street	Officers observed that several plastic zip ties holding up wind sheets at the construction site between Olive Street and Angell Street, next to the Brown Office Building, had been cut. Three panels of the wind sheets were unsecured. Facilities Management was notified of the property damage and a work order was placed to repair it. There are no suspects at this time.
09/21/08 5:55pm	Property Damage / Malicious Intent	New Pembroke #1	An officer reported that the window to the roof had been forced open, but was not damaged. On either side of the window there were buckets and cinder blocks used as a staircase to get to the window in order to force it open. Inside the window, the metal bar leading to the smoke detector had been pried off of the wall. Facilities Management was notified of the damage and a work order was placed. There are no suspects at this time.
09/21/08 7:51pm	Dangerous or Disruptive Behavior	Andrews Hall	Officers were dispatched for a report of a male climbing up the drain pipe and into the second floor window. After a brief investigation, the officer spoke with the student who stated he climbs in and out of his window because it's more fun than taking the stairs. He was advised not to climb into the window anymore and the matter has been turned over to Student Life.

Date & Time Reported	Incident Type	Location	Summary/Disposition
09/22/08 9:53am	Property Damage / Malicious Intent	Champlin Hall	An officer was dispatched to take a report of property damage. Upon arrival, the officer met with a Facilities employee who stated that four chairs were turned over and vandalized in room 110. Three of the four chairs that were turned over had graffiti written on them. There are no suspects at this time.
09/23/08 8:06am	Suspicious Circumstance	Lot 55	An officer was dispatched to meet with some Facilities employees who pointed out that a boat trailer was parked in the grass on the south side of Young Orchard #10. The boat was also crushing some shrubs. The registration on the boat was expired and no information could be obtained.
09/23/08 11:05am	Fire Safety Violation	Minden Hall	An officer was dispatched to the 7th floor for a report that a fire extinguisher had been discharged. A custodian advised the officer that while she was cleaning she observed a powdery substance on the rug. She then found a discharged fire extinguisher near stairwell #2. Fire Safety was advised that the fire extinguisher needed to be replaced or re-charged.
09/23/08 12:28pm	Dangerous or Disruptive Behavior	Sayles Hall	Officers were dispatched for a report of students protesting at the Career Fair. Upon arrival they observed students lying on the stairs of covered with red colored syrup. Inside the hall they also found several other students lying on the floor covered with red syrup. The protestors were obstructing the passage way for all of the people at the career fair and the syrup on the floor was also an obstruction and a hazard. A Dean responded and spoke with the student protestors. They cooperated and left the main hall without incident. Facilities was notified and responded to clean up the syrup on the floor.

09/23/08 8:05pm	Weapons Violation	Minden Hall	At the request of the Office of Student Life, officers were dispatched to recover several knives from a student. The knives were placed into the evidence closet at DPS headquarters pending a University disciplinary hearing.
09/23/08 9:21pm	Suspicious Circumstance	Starr Plaza	Officers were dispatched to meet with a student who stated she was holding a telephone conversation with her mother when she was approached by two significantly larger males. As the two males came closer she became frightened. Two females approaching from another direction scared the two male subjects away. The area was searched but the individuals were not located.
09/24/08 11:10am	Breaking and Entering / No Force	Champlin Hall	A student reported that she left her room at approximately 8:45am while her roommate was still asleep. She reported that when she returned back to her room at 11am her laptop computer was missing. Her roommate reported that when she awoke at approximately 9:20am she went into the bathroom to brush her teeth. When she returned five minutes later she noticed the computer was missing from the room. The computer was not registered with DPS. The door to the room was closed but unlocked. No suspects at this time.
