Date & Time Reported	Incident Type	Location	Summary/Disposition
10/02/08	Larceny	Barbour Hall	Brown student stated that she parked and locked her bike at the bike rack with a combination chain lock. She stated that she saw the bike at approximately 10:23pm on 10/01/08 secured to the bike rack. At approximately 8am on 10/02/08 she went to get her bike and it was gone from the rack. The bike was not registered with the Crime Prevention. There are no suspects at this time.
10/03/08 1:08am	Assist Providence Police / Miscellaneous Noise Complaint	379 Benefit Street	A Brown University police officer was dispatched at the request of the Providence Police for a very loud and out of control party. Providence Police shut down the off campus party and cited two of the tenants. One Brown student and one RISD student. The matter has been turned over to Student Life.
10/03/08 1:30am	Breaking and Entering / No Force	Sears House	A Brown student stated that at approximately 1:25am she had left her room and walked across the hall to the bathroom. She stated that she was away from the room for less than a minute. When she returned to her room her laptop was no longer there.
10/03/08 2:54am	Dangerous or Disruptive Behavior	Wilson Hall	Officers were dispatched for a report of people on the roof. Upon arrival they met with a custodian who stated he heard banging on the roof and immediately called police. Officers went upstairs and observed the hatch door leading to the roof open and subsequently found five people standing on the roof. They were advised to come down. They were identified as four Brown students and one non-Brown student. They stated that they were studying earlier in the evening and then decided to go up on the roof because they were bored. They were informed that the matter would be turned over to Student Life.

10/03/08 8:54am	Assist Providence Police / Miscellaneous	Brook & George Streets	A Brown student, while riding a bike, went through a stop sign and was struck by a vehicle. The student was transported to the hospital by Providence Rescue. The Providence Police cited the student for the accident.
10/04/08 12:51am	Burglary / No Force	Champlin Hall	Two students reported their laptops were stolen from their room. Both students left the room at 11pm on 10/3/08 and found the laptops missing when they returned at 12:45am on 10/4/08. The door was left unlocked
10/04/08 2:04am	Assist Providence Police / Aggravated Assault Assist Providence Police / Arrest	Area of 267 Thayer Street	A Brown University police officer was dispatched to the area of 267 Thayer Street for the report of a student arrested by the Providence Police. Upon arrival, the Providence Police stated that the student kicked out a window of a vehicle and fell to the ground. Four male occupants sitting in the vehicle exited the vehicle and approached the student who was still lying on the ground. The student pulled out a knife and cut one of the subjects on the arm. The student was transported to Providence Central Station and booked. He was charged with malicious damage and assault with a dangerous weapon
10/04/08 2:17am	Assist Providence Police / Simple Assault	Benevolent Street	An officer was dispatched for a Brown student that had just been assaulted. Upon arrival the officer met with the student that advised the officer that he was walking on Benevolent Street while talking on his cell phone when suddenly two males struck him closed fist on the back of his left ear. The student then fell to the ground. The males then proceeded to punch and kick him. At that time while at his post, a Sterling Security employee witnessed the assault and ran over to the victim. This caused the two males to flee in a vehicle. The student declined to file a report with the Providence Police and was transported to the hospital.

10/05/08 1:40am	Shoplifting	Josiah's	The manager advised DPS that he had just returned from chasing two suspects who he observed drink two Vitamin waters and one of them stuffed three Hostess cupcakes into his pockets. The manager said he had never seen the two suspects before and the total of goods taken was approximately twelve dollars.
10/05/08 10:36pm	Simple Assault	314 Benefit Street	A Brown student reported that while riding his bicycle, a four foot long fluorescent light bulb was thrown at him from a vehicle with three male occupants. He stated that the light bulb struck the rear wheel of his bicycle. The student was not injured.
10/06/08 0655	Larceny	Sharpe Refectory	Officers were dispatched to speak with an employee of Dining Services. He stated he left work on Friday 10/03/08 about 3:30pm and returned on 10/06/08 at 6:55am to find that someone had broken into his locker. Culinary art knives, three cheese cutters, and a leather jacket had been taken.
10/06/08 10:26am	Assist Providence Police / Miscellaneous	Sciences Library	Officers responded to the area for the report that a vehicle had hit the railings on the steps of the library and then took off. The railings and cement were damaged. When the operator found that they couldn't get back on the street, due to parked cars, the operator drove through the mulch area, back to the main walkway and then exited out onto Thayer Street. Providence Police responded and the operator was located.
10/07/08 8:56pm	Suspicious Behavior Harassment / Verbal	Thayer Street near Sciences Library	A student stated that she was walking on Thayer Street when a black SUV slowed down as it passed her. Someone yelled to her from the vehicle and she was disturbed by the incident. She said she has seen this vehicle in the area before and witnessed the vehicle slow down and watch as females are walking, which "creeped her out". The case is under investigation.

Date & Time Reported	Incident Type	Location	Summary/Disposition
10/08/08 12:43pm	Vandalism / Malicious Injury to Property	Jameson House and Poland House	Officers were dispatched to meet with a custodian regarding vandalism to several bathrooms. Someone had spray painted graffiti in several places and it was also noticed that someone had silk screened an image with black paint on some mirrors and various walls.
10/08/08 10:10pm	Assist Providence Police / Miscellaneous	Soldier's Arch	An officer was dispatched and met with a student who told him that around 12pm he was lightly hit by a car while riding his skateboard. He stated that he was traveling through Soldiers Arch and that he slowed down before entering the crosswalk and assumed that the vehicle approaching the crosswalk saw him. The vehicle continued into the crosswalk without stopping and only stopped after running over his skateboard. The student stated that he ended up in front of the vehicle with his hands on the hood. He then asked the male driver to back up so he could get his skateboard out from under his car, which he did. He then stated that the driver scolded him for running into the crosswalk and drove off. Providence Police took a report.
