Date & Time Reported	Incident Type	Location	Summary/Disposition
10/16/08 3:02pm	Narcotics Violation	Young Orchard #4	An officer was dispatched to meet with a dean regarding a health & safety inspection. The dean stated that while conducting the check of the room she observed a glass pipe with marijuana in it. Also in plain view, the officer observed what appeared to be a quantity of a greenish/brownish substance in a clear bag which he believed to be marijuana. The pipe and the marijuana were seized by DPS. The pipe and the green leafy substance were taken back to 75 Charlesfield Street, department headquarters, where a field test was conducted using a narcotics analysis kit. The test showed positive for marijuana. The matter is being handled by Student Life.
10/18/08 12:06am	Larceny	Lot 75	Student stated that her car had been broken into and the driver's side door control panel for the power windows, locks and mirrors had been taken, along with her anti- theft device.
10/19/08 1:14am	Shoplifting	Josiah's	A manager observed an individual sticking their hands into a pan of french fries and eating them. The pan of french fries was then thrown away. The student was warned about his behavior by the manager. Approximately five minutes later the manager observed the same student eating french fries out of the pan again and drinking a Vitamin Water. The manager informed the student that he had to pay for the items he ate and drank. The student stated that he did not have his ID and did not have any money to pay for the items. The manager told officers he did not wish to press charges but would like Josiah's to be compensated for the loss. The matter has been turned over to Student Life.

10/19/08 8:24am	Burglary / No Force	Diman House	A student reported that she had gone to bed at approximately 11:30pm on 10/18/08 and when she woke up at about 7:45am she noticed that her laptop computer had been taken from her desk. The door to the room was left unlocked.
10/19/08 2:02pm	Breaking and Entering / No Force	Jameson House	A student stated he brought a speaker to his friend's room so they could listen to some music. He left the speaker in a closet for about a week. When he contacted his friend about retrieving the speaker, she was unable to find it.
10/19/08 9:45pm	Assist Providence Police / Larceny	Bowen Street	A Brown student reported that someone had smashed the passenger's side window of his vehicle and stole his GPS. Providence Police responded and took the report.

10/21/08 7:36am	Suspicious Circumstance	Sciences Library	A student was found sleeping on the roof. He stated that he had been sleeping there lately because he spends many hours working on a project and it was easier than going home. He was escorted off the roof and the matter has been turned over to Student Life.
10/21/08 4:36pm	Larceny	CIT	A student stated that on 10/20/08 she took her laptop and the recovery disks to the help desk. She stated that at 3pm she placed her items on the counter while her computer was being checked out by a technician. She returned to the counter at 5pm and noticed that her recovery disks were taken. It is possible that another customer may have accidentally taken them. The case is under investigation.
