Date & Time Reported	Incident Type	Location	Summary/Disposition
11/08/08 9:32am	Breaking & Entering / No Force	Archibald House	A student reported his unattended and empty laundry bag was taken on 11/07/08 between 6:30pm and 7:10pm.
11/09/08 12:23pm	Larceny	Sharpe Refectory	An employee stated that between 8am and 10:30am an unknown person took his cell phone and two dollars out of his pants pocket. The pants were left unattended and unsecured on a clothes rack in the men's locker room while he worked. The locker room is left unsecured.
11/09/08 2:24pm	Larceny	OMAC	Student stated that he was playing basketball between 6 and 7pm on 11/08/08, when person(s) unknown took his debit card and \$40.00 from his jacket pocket. His jacket was left unattended and unsecured on the floor of the gym. The debit card was used at retail establishments in Johnston.
11/09/08 2:30pm	Burglary / No Force	Archibald House	Student reported that someone had entered his room between 2 and 3am and stole a pair of tan shorts that were hanging on a chair. He stated that at approximately 2am he had returned to his room. He then left the room to use the bathroom. He closed the door, but left it unlocked. He stated that when he returned to the room, he locked the door then went to bed. He stated that when he woke up at approximately 11am he noticed the shorts were missing. In the pockets was his wallet containing his driver's license, two debit cards, a credit card, Brown University ID, \$8.00 in cash and keys. On 11/10/08 the student called detectives to report that all of his property was returned by two unnamed students who found it in another area.

11/09/08 5:57pm	Larceny	OMAC	Two students reported that at approximately 5pm they had placed their belongings on the floor as they worked out. When they returned about an hour later, they noticed that some items were missing. Two cell phones, a hand purse, dorm key, debit cards, credit cards, Brown IDs, cash, a wallet, driver's license, a personal check and a number of gift cards were taken. A witness stated she observed two male subjects running from the area. The males were running toward the rear door which would take them into Lot #87. One of the subjects dropped a wallet as they ran passed her. She picked up the wallet and returned it to him, not knowing of the larceny. The two subjects were seen getting into a light blue vehicle with another male subject driving.
11/09/08 8:25pm	Suspicious Circumstance	Power and Brook Streets	An officer responded to the intersection of Power and Brook Streets in reference to a possible motor vehicle theft. A Brown student stated he was unable to find his vehicle which he said was parked on Waterman Street. He also stated he had looked for the vehicle for a while and believed it had been stolen. At this time the officer escorted him around to search for the vehicle. The student was then dropped off at the PPD substation to file a report. A while later the student flagged down another Brown police officer and stated the vehicle had been found at the intersection at Benevolent and Brook Streets.
11/09/08 10:10pm	Breaking and Entering / No Force	Sears House	A student reported that he went out of state on 11/06/08 at 3pm and when he returned on 11/09/08 at approximately 8pm he found his laptop missing. He reported his roommate was on campus the whole time but had no idea the laptop was missing.
11/10/08 10am	Larceny	Caswell Hall	Student stated that on Thursday 11/06/08 at about 7pm she locked her bike to a tree. The tree is located at the south west corner of Caswell. She noticed the bike missing when she returned to campus on 11/08/08 at about 8am. She called detectives on 11/11/08 and said her bike was returned to her.

11/10/08 7:21pm	Larceny	CIT	A student stated that while in the ladies rest room on the first floor, she placed her cell phone on top of the towel dispenser and forgot it there. She stated that she noticed it missing right away and returned to the ladies room two minutes later but could not find it anywhere in the area. The student emailed DPS on 11/11/08 stating she found her phone.
11/13/08 8:05pm	Trespass	Hegeman Hall	A male subject was trespassed from University property after he had been observed by female students peeping in their first floor dorm window.
