Date & Time Reported	Incident Type	Location	Summary/Disposition
12/18/08 3:02pm	Breaking and Entering / No Force	Woolley Hall	Student reported that at approximately 2:30pm she went to use the shower. At approximately 2:40pm she returned back to her room which she had left unlocked, and her laptop and iPod were missing.
12/18/08 3:03pm	Breaking and Entering / No Force	Poland House	Student reported that he had left to go to lunch at approximately 1:45pm. Upon returning to his room at approximately 2:45pm he observed that his room door was open and the lights were out in the room. He stated that he was unsure if he had locked his room when he left for lunch. He walked into the room, turned the light on and observed that his laptop was missing from the desk where he had left it.

When he returned at 2:30pm he noticed the laptop missing. He also stated he shares the space with a lab mate who was in the room but did not notice anyone or anything out of the ordinary.
12/18/08 4:12pm	Larceny	Metcalf Copy Center	The photo editor for the yearbook committee reported that on 11/19/08 someone went to sign out a camera for use and it was discovered that two cameras and their cases were missing.

12/21/05 1:40am	Burglary / No Force	Marcy House	A student reported that three laptops, an iPhone and a television were stolen from his dorm room. One laptop was his; the other belonged to a roommate and the other laptop belonged to a friend of his roommate. He stated that he left his room for ten minutes. When he returned he discovered the items missing. The door was left unlocked.
12/22/08 1:37pm	Weapons Violation	VG Quad A	While on detail doing dorm checks an officer found in plain view on a desk a sword in a sheath. It was confiscated, and brought to department headquarters and tagged as evidence. The matter has been turned over to Student Life.
01/02/09 10:26pm	Assist Providence Police / Breaking & Entering No Force	134 Hope Street	Brown University professor reported to the Providence and Brown Police that he left his residence on 12/31/08 at 4pm and when he returned on 01/02/09 at 5:20pm he found the front door wide open. Upon checking the residence several items were found missing: 2 laptop computers, jewelry and a camera. There are no suspects at this time.
01/06/09 8:06pm	Burglary	Sharpe Refectory	An employee reported that he left his office at approximately 4pm, locking the door behind him as he exited. Upon his arrival back to his office an hour later, he unlocked the door and found that his personal keys to his vehicle and home, along with his cell phone, cell phone charger and his black leather gloves were stolen from his office desk area. A search of the immediate area met with negative results in locating his belongings. The case is under investigation

01/09/08 4:26pm	Larceny	Life Sciences	Employee reported that he left his wallet containing \$145.00 in another room under a jacket while he and a co-worker set up for a medical exam of a patient. A short time later he discovered the cash missing. The patient was left alone in the same room as the wallet. The case is under investigation.
