12/12/11 8:09am	Larceny	Creative Arts Center	Assistant Director stated that persons unknown entered the building and took a piece of art work, a banana shaped pillow. The pillow is part of an art project and is owned by a Brown student. She had sent out an e-mail to the building staff inquiring if anyone had seen the pillow; however no one had any information.
12/12/11 4:36pm	Larceny	Lot 68	Reporting party stated that he parked his vehicle at approximately 9:15am. Upon his arrival back to his vehicle at approximately 4:36pm he observed the vehicle to have sustained a smashed out passengers side front window and stated that his GPS was missing.
12/17/11 5:06pm	Larceny	Young Orchard #2	Student left his bike at 8:30pm on 12/16/11. When he returned on 12/17/11 at 1:30am he found the bike seat, battery operated bicycle lights and a bike pump missing from the bike.

01/30/12 5:35pm	Larceny	Pizzitola	Student reported that he arrived at the Pizzitola at approximately 1:30pm and placed his things in his locker and went to the OMAC to work out. When he returned to his locker at approximately 5:15pm he discovered that his wallet was no longer in the pocket of his pants that he left there, and it was just thrown in the locker. Forty dollars in cash was missing from the wallet. He also advised that the lockers do not have locks.
