Date & Time Reported	Incident Type	Location	Summary/Disposition
03/12/11 3:36pm	Larceny	Blue Room	Student reported his cellular phone was stolen. At approximately 2:30pm he placed his phone down on a table to move another table when he returned to pick up his phone thirty seconds later the phone was missing.
03/19/11 12:14am	Assist Providence Police / Noise Complaint	63 Governor Street	Brown University Police officers were dispatched to meet with Providence Police to assist in dispersing a large house party. Providence Police cited the Brown student who hosted the party.
03/19/11 1:00am	Assist Providence Police / Noise Complaint	70 Brook Street	Brown University police were dispatched to assist Providence Police with a large party as they were receiving numerous loud music complaints. A Brown student was cited by the Providence Police for a violation of the city noise ordinance.
03/20/11 12:13am	Assist Providence Police / Noise Complaint	63 Governor Street	Brown University Police were dispatched with Providence Police to 63 Governor Street after Providence Police received several calls of a loud disruptive party at that location. When officers arrived about 120 people were on the street and adjacent properties and the group was loud and boisterous and yelled obscenities at the police from the curb. Officers made entry into the residence and found that the resident, a Brown student, had a DJ and had been charging admission for the event. There were approximately 200 people in the first floor and back yard. When a Brown University police officer asked about the admission being charged the student said it was for a charity but refused to name which one. The student was cited by the Providence Police for a noise violation.

03/19/11 8:31pm	Larceny	Olney Margolies Athletic Center	Student stated that he went to an intramural tournament that was being held at the OMAC at 2:10pm. He then left his book bag with his iPod Touch inside. The book bag was left unattended on the gym floor with other book bags. When he looked for his it at 3:40pm it was gone.
03/20/11 12:39am	Assist Providence Police / Noise Complaint	176 Williams Street	Brown Police were dispatched to 176 Williams Street after Providence Police called for assistance. Upon the arrival of both agencies a large group of people were leaving and bottles could be heard crashing onto the pavement. After making entry into the residence over 100 people were observed crowded into the third floor apartment. The Brown students were cautioned about the dangers of overcrowding in the residence and were cited by Providence Police for a noise ordinance violation.
03/21/11 11:25am	Larceny	Olney Margolies Athletic Center	Reporting party stated that on 03/16/2011 at 5pm she put her small black leather purse on the side of the wall near the track and went to run. After she was done running at 6pm she proceeded back to the wall to get her purse and noticed it was missing.
03/24/11 9:40pm	Assist Providence Police / Arrest	281 Brook Street	Brown police officers were dispatched to assist the Providence Police as they were refused entry into the residence. Inside the residence were multiple minor Brown students who stated they were served alcohol by another Brown student. The Providence Police took four kegs of beer and taps as evidence. Two Brown students were arrested. One of them was released after providing a witness statement regarding what he and the other students took part in. The case has also been turned over to the Office of Student Life.

03/29/11 1:23pm	Breaking & Entering / No Force	Minden Hall	Brown student stated that on Saturday, March 26th he returned from Boston with food. He placed the food in the refrigerator in the kitchen area and when he returned on 03/29 the food was gone.
03/30/11 6:12pm	Breaking & Entering / Force	70 Brown Street	Reporting party stated that she secured her laptop computer to a Kensington cable at approximately 6:30pm on 03/28/11. Upon her return on 03/30/11 at 8am she noticed person(s) unknown had forcefully entered her office which she shares with two other females and her laptop was forcefully removed from its locking port.
