Date & Time Reported	Incident Type	Location	Summary/Disposition
04/01/11 6:05pm	Assist Providence Police / Breaking & Entering	204 Angell Street	Brown student stated she left her apartment on 03/25/11 at approximately 6pm and returned on 04/01/11 at approximately 5:30pm and discovered her apartment was broken into. The exterior door on the north side of the apartment had what appeared to be pry marks located on the door next to the lock mechanism. She reported her laptop was taken from her room. Providence Police took a report.
04/01/11 7:13pm	Assist Providence Police / Larceny	Starbucks	Providence Police notified Brown Police that a Brown University student stated that her laptop was stolen while she was working on a project. She stated that at approximately 7pm she was sitting at a table with her laptop in front of her when she heard male yell out "do it now!" When she looked outside the window another male grabbed her laptop and ran out the door.
04/02/11 4:59pm	Larceny	Alumnae Hall	Complainant stated that she had been in a meeting and had placed her black bag at the coat rack outside of the auditorium. She last saw her bag at 2pm. When she returned again to that location at 5:45pm she noticed that her bag was missing. The bag contained dirty socks and a mouth guard.
04/03/11 5:04pm	Breaking & Entering / Force	Taubman Center	Professor reported that he returned from break and found his office door kicked in and his laptop was missing. Another laptop was missing from a study room and other office doors were found kicked in. The case is under investigation by Brown University Detectives.

04/04/11 10:11am	Larceny / Arrest Made	Manning Walkway	A Brown police officer observed two males removing a rear wheel from a bicycle. She requested additional officers and gave a description of the suspects. They were located and were in possession of the tire which was removed from a student's bicycle. They were both trespassed from University property and the subject that had the tire was arrested.
04/05/11 12:47pm	Larceny	20 Benevolent Street	A Brown University Dean stated that between 10am and 7pm on 04/04/11 person(s) unknown entered her office and took her iPad from the top of her desk. Between those times she periodically left her office and closed the door without locking it
04/05/11 1:26pm	Larceny	70 Brown Street	A Brown student employee reported that she walked to the office across from her office and was gone for about four to five minutes. When she returned to her office her laptop was missing.
04/06/11 12:41pm	Narcotic Violation	Chapin House	An officer was dispatched for the report of drug paraphernalia found during a Health and Safety Inspection team. In a room in plain view was a wooden marijuana pipe and in a 35mm film container there was a small amount of what looked and smelled like marijuana. They spoke to a student in the room who said it was not his. The case has been turned over to the Office of Student Life.

04/09/11 1:21am	Assist Providence Police / Noise Complaint	37 Charlesfield Street	Brown officers were dispatched for the report of a noise complaint. Upon arrival they observed a large crowd of approximately 300 students in the backyard, with a disc jockey playing music. The disc jockey was advised to turn down the music and notify the owner. PPD units also responded to help disperse the large gathering. They met with a Brown University student who reported to be the only resident at the location. She said that she was the host of the party and stated that she was not serving alcohol, however there was alcohol observed. She stated that the crowd became too large for her to supervise. She was cited by the Providence Police for the noise complaint.
04/11/11 1:15pm	Breaking & Entering / No Force	Jameson House	Student stated that between 9:30am and noon person(s) unknown took her clothes out of an unattended clothes dryer and placed them in a pile on top of the machine. Missing from the pile were jackets, tank tops, sweaters, a Brown University hoodie and one pair of Brown University sweatpants.
04/13/11 10:52pm	Larceny	Sayles Hall	Brown University student that her jacket and sweater were stolen from under a chair while she went to use the restroom during a show. She said her friends were there when she left but they did not see anyone remove the jacket. Her cell phone, keys, debit card and other items were in her jacket.
