The Sheridan Center Moves

As of January 13, 2003, the Harriet W. Sheridan Center for Teaching and Learning will be in a new location at 96 Waterman Street. The building will house a library, mock classrooms and several consultation rooms, as well as offices. The halls will be used as an art gallery for changing student exhibits organized by the Department of Visual Art. CIS, the Library (Media Services) and the Sheridan Center have collaborated to allocate space and install electronic technology to provide faculty and graduate students with a central location in which to explore effective pedagogy across the curriculum.
