PRESENTATION CONSULTATIONS a NEW Sheridan Center service for Faculty and Graduate Students

Presentation skills are integral to effective communication of scholarly research and/or course content for all members of the Brown community, whether faculty, administrative staff, graduate or undergraduate students. Both departments and individual scholars at Brown have articulated an interest in getting feedback on presentations. As a result, the Sheridan Center is offering a new service designed to provide immediate feedback for those who are giving:

- conference presentations
- departmental colloquia presentations (journal clubs, lunch bunches, etc.)
- dissertation presentations
- presentations of research outside the typical classroom setting job talks

This service is intended for members of the Brown community who wish to practice their presentation in advance with a trained Sheridan Center consultant. Upon request, the Center will send one or two trained consultants to videotape the practice session. Consultants will then remain to watch the videotape with the presenter and offer immediate feedback and suggestions.
