**FLEXIBLE FLYER AWARD  
\$600**

**AWARD FOR 2007/2008**

An anonymous gift from a graduate of Brown University who majored in the art department established the **FLEXIBLE FLYER FUND**. It permits an annual award of \$600 to aid an undergraduate independent student project by an art concentrator whose center of interest is in the Visual Arts or History of Art and Architecture and who specifically envisions a career in some aspect of art: artist, art historian, museum curator, critic, etc. **JUNIORS AND SENIORS ONLY ARE ELIGIBLE TO APPLY.** Independent concentrators may apply as long as they plan a career in some aspect of art.

The award is alternated each year between the Department of Visual Art and the Department of History of Art and Architecture. This year's award will be given to a student in **HISTORY OF ART AND ARCHITECTURE**.

Eligible Projects may be done as completely independent projects outside of Brown, as independent study projects, or as work within the regular department curriculum. A student may not use the award while on leave from Brown, but it may be used in part for a summer project undertaken between junior and senior years, or for the completion of a project begun at Brown and finished during the summer following graduation.

Applicants should supply the following:

1. An account of the project and the way in which the award will aid in its realization.
2. An account of the way in which this project will benefit you in furthering your studies or experience. The award is not specifically career oriented and should not be predominately viewed as funding for direct professional training. It is broadly educational in purpose and for the student with a serious commitment to a career in some aspect of art.
3. No more than two written or visual samples of work in art history or architectural studies.

Enclose all items in a manila envelope directed to the Art History Department Secretary, List 223, labeled on the outside for FLEXIBLE FLYER award.
