# Summer Research and Related Work

- Thesis is required for both AB and ScB
  - AB language “Seniors are encouraged to investigate topics of current importance and often choose to study regional environmental problems.”
  - ScB language “The thesis must have a primary science focus involving laboratory or field work or modeling and it must involve policy relevant science with broad environmental relevance

# UTRA

Undergraduate Teaching and Research Assistantship

- Application Due Beginning of February to Dean of the College
- Work closely in research situations with faculty
- 10 week commitment, \$3000 stipend



# Liman Public Interest Summer Fellowship

- Application due January 30, 2009 through Swearer Center
- Supports otherwise unpaid law internships in a broad range of public interest law



# Royce Fellowship

- Applications Due mid-late February
- Awarded to as many as 20 students annually with financial support to pursue a project of their own design in research, service, or cultural production
- Strong representation from ES in past years



# CV Starr National Service Fellowship

- Application due late February through Swearer Center
- Provides an opportunity to deepen understanding of critical public issues as part of a liberal education
- For students with a demonstrated pattern of service





# Howard R. Swearer International Service Fellowship

- Applications due mid March through the Swearer Center
- Public service in an international context
- Up to \$3000
- Preference for developing or underdeveloped countries
- May involve working with existing non-profits, relief agencies, or government agencies, or initiating a new effort in a broad range of fields



# **Brown Internship Assistance Program and Aided Internship Program**

- Applications Due mid-March through Career Services
- For summer internships that are supervised and unpaid/low-paying
- Finances outside internships for students “in a field that they intend to pursue after graduation”

# Morris K. Udall Scholarship

- Application due Late February
- 80 national scholarships of \$5000
- Sophomores or Juniors who study the environment or related fields or have ties to Native American Communities
- Must be nominated by  
Brown
