

PRE-REGISTRATION PERIOD FOR SPANISH LANGUAGE COURSES IN THE FALL 2009

- IN ORDER TO GIVE THE NECESSARY ATTENTION TO STUDENTS IN SPANISH LANGUAGE CLASSES, WE LIMIT COURSE ENROLLMENT.
 - HISP 100-500 =18 STUDENTS
 - HISP 600 = 15 STUDENTS

FOR STUDENTS ALREADY IN THE PROGRAM AND STUDENTS RETURNING FROM STUDY ABROAD:

- Very important: As you may know, when you pre-register for a Spanish course in the fall, Banner will check if you have fulfilled the pre-requisites indicated in the course description for such course. Since you are already in the language program, Banner will look at the course that you are currently taking before entering your registration in the next course in the language sequence. Therefore Banner will not allow you to skip a level.
- When the course reaches the number of students allowed at this time [see information above] pre-registration for this section will be blocked and will indicate “written permission required.” If this happens to you, please put your name on the wait list for the course as indicated below. No registration overrides will be granted until the fall 2009 when classes are finalized. If you have any concerns, please talk to Nidia Schuhmacher, Director of the Language Program or the Course Supervisor.

- **VERY IMPORTANT:**
Students planning to spend time in a Spanish-speaking country and/or to take academic courses in Spanish in the summer **must** see either Prof. Beth Bauer [names with A-L] or Prof. Victoria Smith [names with M-Z] regarding transfer credit before the end of this semester. Spending time abroad and/or taking courses not approved for credit **does not prepare students** appropriately to skip a course in the Brown Spanish program sequence.
- Moreover, the Brown Language Placement Exam cannot be taken **to assess progress and skip a course in the language sequence.**

As shopping period changes students' decisions, class membership will be finalized after the beginning of the semester on the 4th day of class. As in the past, pre-registered students **must attend the first four days to maintain their pre-registered status.**

Wait lists will be available through pre-registration and they will close by Monday, May 4th.

While these lists do not guarantee a spot nor do they give you priority in the course in which you expect to register, they will help the faculty assess and adjust the number of course sections available so that most students seeking to study Spanish in the FALL 2009 can meet their language needs.
