

WHERE IS THE CONCERT?

The concert performed by the West-Eastern Divan Orchestra, Daniel Barenboim, conducting, will be held at the VMA Arts and Cultural Center, 1 Avenue of the Arts, Providence, RI.

HOW MAY I GET A TICKET?

Tickets are free and may be obtained at the Office of University Events, 71 George Street, from 9am-5pm, Monday, 12/4 to Wednesday, 12/6. The limit is two tickets per person. Community groups interested in reserving blocks of seats, or anyone needing further information, should call the ticket hotline at (401) 863-1055.

MAY I RESERVE TICKETS UP TO CONCERT TIME?

No. You may reserve and/or pick up your tickets until 5 pm on December 6th in the Office of University Events, 71 George Street. All remaining tickets will be transferred to the will-call window at the VMA. The will-call window will be open from 9 am through curtain on the 16th.

WHAT IF I LOSE MY TICKETS?

Lost tickets cannot be replaced. If there are remaining tickets available, you may obtain another pair of tickets at the will-call at the VMA on the 16th.

WHEN WILL THE DOORS OF VETERANS MEMORIAL AUDITORIUM OPEN?

Will-call will be open from 9 am through the 2 pm curtain on the 16th. The doors will open for seating one hour before the performance.

WHAT IF I ARRIVE LATE?

Latecomers may be seated only at an appropriate interval (i.e., at the conclusion of a work).

ARE CAMERAS OR TAPE RECORDERS ALLOWED?

No photography or recording equipment of any kind is permitted. Those found violating this policy will be escorted from the theatre.

ARE THERE OTHER RESTRICTIONS?

Backpacks, large parcels and shopping bags will not be permitted in the theatre.
