Students who are enrolled in or have completed at least one 1000-level workshop (or independent study) may submit honors applications to the Literary Arts Program from **September 7 – 20, 2010**. Applications are due in the Literary Arts building by **20 September**, and should be delivered in person or sent by US mail. **No email or fax submissions will be considered.**
