

Application for 2008 Sport and Society Fellowship

Title and abstract (100 words)

Describe the project you wish to undertake

Project Statement: (2 pages)

- Please discuss your research or applied project that explores the intersection of sport and human rights.
- Please discuss what skills and knowledge you currently possess that make you an appropriate candidate for the work you propose.
- What challenges does the experience present for you? (What experiences, knowledge, skills do you lack?)

Personal statement: (2 pages)

- Please discuss the role sport has played in your life and how you have experienced the intersection of academics and sport.
- How has your thinking about sport and the role of sport in your life changed over time?

Timeline: (1page)

Identify the significant parts of the proposal and offer a clear start and end date for your work. (The project may take place over the summer or during the academic year. At a minimum the project must be 10 weeks in duration).

Budget: (1 page)

Describe how you will use the award funds.

Resume: (1 page)

Include an updated resume of your work, sport activities and interests.

Letters of support

Applicants must submit at least one letter from a Brown faculty, coach or staff member. Letters must be signed originals and must be submitted in a sealed envelope or mailed directly to the Director of the Fellowship.

If you are proposing to work with an established NGO or agency you must submit a letter from the organization inviting you in.
