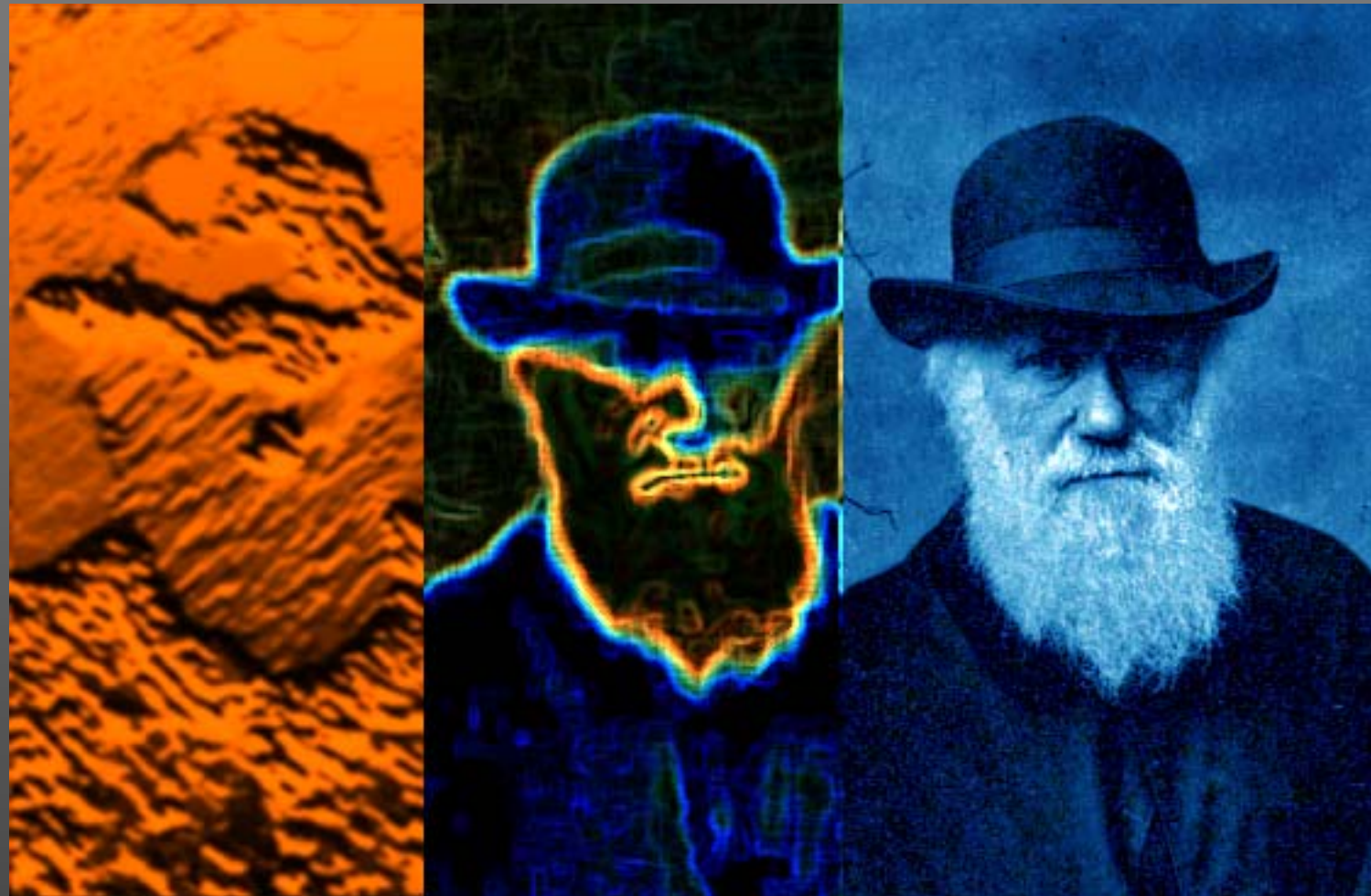


# DARWIN'S EVOLUTION
