



DEA operation. At the request of the two DEA officers who originated the contact in Lebanon, I met with their asset in Washington. Last week, their intermediary expressed concern with proceeding with the operation based on the instability inside Lebanon. In response to their urgings (the DEA officers were made aware of the possibility that the Dawa prisoners could be executed shortly after the end of Ramadan-June 19) and the death of one of his contacts inside Lebanon, he has now agreed to proceed as follows:

-- Once contact has been established and a meeting arranged, the two DEA officers will depart for Cyprus via Vienna where they will deposit the \$200K and establish an account for the \$2M (\$500K of which will be available immediately in U.S. dollars cash for use in Lebanon). Tarallo will then proceed to the meeting indicated above.

The following six people were killed in the Kuwaiti bombing on December 12, 1984. The first four were killed instantion.

Ryad Mustim Agil:

The driver of the suicide car. An Iraqi carrying an Armenian passport. He was atomized (the body was completely blown up:

Alr Al-Jamal:

Foreman of a contracting company carrying out repairs at the embassy. A Palestinian from Jordan. Injuries to the lower half of his body. The legs were missing. 80% of his body was burned. The eyes were missing.

Mufad Hakim Mufid:

The embassy FSN driver/purchaser. A Syrian. Skull injuries. Multiple shrapnel wounds. Severed right femer.

Ahmad Mahmud:

Embassy FSN driver. A Palestinian from Jordan. Crushed by a falling wall.

Natib Al-Rafai:

A visa applicant. A Kuwaiti. Suffered head injuries. Died on December 15, 1984 in the hospital.

Unidentified:

A Egyptian. Rilled in a separate bombing at the airport on December 13, 1984.





The DEA officers are prepared to take leave as soon as they are contacted by Travel arrangements and operational costs are currently being financed from funds normally available to the Nicaraguan resistance. Our normal point-of-contact in the resistance for these matters is not yet aware.

Summary. As discussed with ADM Poindexter, it appears that both these plans can proceed simultaneously without undue concern for compromise or-mutual jeopardy. Given that arrangements for the DEA operation will take considerable time (contacts inside Lebanon, financial transactions, and rental of yacht/safehouse).
