Refund Policy

Because of unexpected conflicts, some students may find it necessary to drop out after they have signed up for BOLT and paid their fee. This causes a wide variety of logistical problems. We must admit new people, send out new mailings, rearrange our rosters, and make a number of other adjustments. Furthermore, after the beginning of July it becomes increasingly difficult to find students from the waiting list who are able to change their plans to participate in the program. We highly recommend that you contact us immediately when you have determined you can not participate.

We are only able to provide refunds to students if we are notified of your change in status before July 31st.
