Alpha Chi Omega: Warning

Buxton International House: Warning

Buxton has significantly fewer mandatory meetings than any other house. We suggest that Buxton make its Sunday Brunches into informal meetings, in order to increase the frequency of face-to-face exchange of information.

Kappa Alpha Theta: Warning

Kappa Alpha Theta has no faculty advisor, although we understand that they are in the process of acquiring one. If they do not have an advisor by next fall, they should expect to fail Fall Review. Additionally, they have struggled with numbers for some time, but anticipate ample members next year. If they do not have enough members next year, they should expect to fail Fall Review.

Theta Delta Chi: Warning

Theta Delta Chi has no bylaws. While we recognize the informal nature of decision-making at this house, every house is required to have some set of regulations on file with Residential Life. If this issue is not remedied, they should expect to fail Fall Review.

Cooking House: Fail

Failure due to anticipated low membership (20) and low returning membership (2) for the coming fall semester. Cooking House should remedy this issue in their recruitment next year if they desire to continue as a Program House.

Delta Phi: Fail

Failure due to continuing low membership (16) and low anticipated membership (21) and returning membership for next fall, as well as lateness (1 day) of submitted Spring Review materials. Membership issues have been an ongoing issue for Delta Phi; however, we applaud their increased recruitment efforts this year which have resulted in less-weak in-house membership anticipated for next year.

Phi Kappa Psi: Fail

Failure due to lateness (4 days) and significant incompleteness of submitted Spring Review materials, especially failure to include any information about Community Service events. The sale of "Thayer Street" discount cards does not constitute sufficient service and commitment to count toward Community Service requirements.

Sigma Chi: Fail

Failure due to absence at Spring Review. Failure to provide sufficient information and documentation regarding Campus-Wide events. Failure to explain why their Independent Liaison has not contacted all residents of their building.
