## Code of Conduct

### Community Values and Expectations

In Hawaii you will be privileged to explore some of the most fragile and diverse ecosystems in the world. You will experience Hawaii as a student of the environment, not as a tourist. Your peers are students from all over the United States and like you, they share a commitment to learning and respect for the environment. We expect that you will challenge yourself and each other as we live and learn together. Our goal is to build a powerful learning community where all members are respected, supported and challenged.

In order to ensure that the program can dedicate itself fully to its academic and educational mission, students are expected to adhere to all relevant University rules and regulations. Continuing Education has additional policies and procedures, including but not limited to the following:

**Respect for Others.** Brown is a community that consists of people of different backgrounds and beliefs. Conduct that is disrespectful or in violation of the rights of others, including, but not limited to, verbal, physical, or sexual harassment, and bias-related harassment will not be tolerated and may result in disciplinary action and sanctions, including possible dismissal from the program.

**Illegal Substances.** Possession, use, distribution or being in the presence of alcohol and illegal drugs is not permitted. Violation of this policy is grounds for disciplinary action and may result in dismissal from the program.

**Damage or Loss.** Students are expected to respect the environment and property of all the sites we visit. Students shall assume all financial responsibility for loss or damage they cause to property. The responses to damaged/lost property may include replacement, clean-up and labor costs.

**Weapons.** Dangerous weapons such as firearms and knives are strictly prohibited. Local police or program staff will confiscate a weapon and investigate the student who possesses it; in addition, the student will face sanctions.

Staff members will outline expectations at the beginning of the program, including a strict policy prohibiting the use of alcohol and other drugs. In a case where a student, in the judgment of the staff, fails to meet the established expectations for student conduct, or shows disregard for staff directives, disciplinary action will be taken which may include: a warning, probation, consultation with parents, or in cases of serious or repeated behavioral problems, dismissal from the program. Financial obligations arising from dismissal from the program, including travel costs, are the responsibility of the student and parents/guardians. Should a student be dismissed from the program for any reason, tuition, fees, travel costs and any other program-related expenses will not be refunded.
