

## OVERVIEW OF THE SAFE COMPUTING CD

Below are the first folders seen on this CD.



When you double-click on the **PC Folder**, it is separated into two folders. One is the Applications Folder which contains installer files for the Firefox and Safari internet browsers. The other contains documentation on these and other tools.



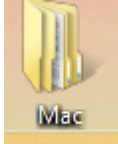
Other items in **The Application Folder** contain:

- The installer for **SecureW2** which is needed when using Brown-Secure wireless.
- The **Antivirus Spyware folder** has the installer for **Spybot**, which is a program that removes spyware from your computer.
- **WinSockFix** offers a last resort if your Internet connectivity has been corrupted due to invalid or removed registry entries. It can often cure the problem of lost connections after the removal of Adware components or improper uninstall of firewall applications or other tools that modify the XP network and Winsock settings.

Items in **The Documentation Folder** contain:

- The **Symantec** installation instructions for Windows XP and Vista. The installer is not supplied on this CD because you must verify that you are a Brown student by providing your username and password in order to complete the install. Symantec can be installed from our website at: <http://software.brown.edu>.
- Instructions for installing **Malwarebytes**, a new program that is for personal use only, are also included. Malwarebytes has shown great results in removing malware from computers that are infected with a variety of viruses and spyware.
- Instructions on how to start **Windows in Safe Mode** to run virus scans. Scans in Safe Mode are more effective, as many viruses attach themselves to start up programs on your computer.
- Instructions on how to connect to Brown-Secure with Windows XP and Vista are located in the **BrownSecurePC folder**.

- The procedure for **running a CHKDSK** on Windows XP and Vista are also included. **CHKDSK** can repair problems related to bad sectors, lost clusters, cross-linked files, and directory errors.
- The **Windows Defender** instructions for Windows XP and Windows Vista is included and is an additional program for protecting your computer from various viruses and spyware that may attack your system.
- The final documentation is **printing from laptop to a cluster printer**. This allows you to use your own laptop but be able to print out your work to any of CIS' computer cluster printers.



The **Mac Folder** is also separated into an **Applications** and **Documentation Folder**. The Applications Folder contains the installer files for Mozilla Firefox.

The **Mac Documentation Folder** contains:

- Instructions for **Connecting to Brown-Secure** using either Mac OS 10.4x (Tiger) or 10.5x (Leopard) are included in this folder.
- It also has the **printing from laptop to a cluster printer** instructions.
- The **Symantec** installation instructions for Mac users. The installer is not supplied on this CD because you must verify they you are a Brown student by providing your username and password in order to complete the install.
